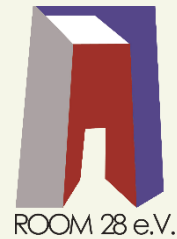


Easter Greetings. Room 28 Newsletter.

along with my is Easter greetings I would like to share news about our current project:

A Gift event for Ukrainian children.

I am delighted to write that we have agreed upon two events: In Berlin with the **J-Art-Eck Educational Center** (May 2024) and in Munich with the **Janusz-Korczak- Academy** (June 2024). The events will be preceded by music workshops. Some children will take part in the event, two will sing the song of the airplane and several children will sing the lullaby and the finale.

As you can see, the concept of the events has taken shape. Children can take part and rehearse songs in a music-workshop and then sing along at the event - in Ukrainian or German, anything is possible. From our side, **Andreas Jocksch** (member of Ensemble Zwöckhaus) will read from the book and also sing the two songs from Brundibár. In Munich, the project will be accompanied by the outstanding accordion player **Konstantin Ischenko**. Also, **Susanne Gargerle**, first violinist of the Bavarian State Opera in Munich and member of Room 28, is ready to play a serenade to the night scene. Thank you to all those who take interest and support our project!

Our project is **a sign of Solidarity with Ukraine**. We give Ukrainian children a copy of the Ukrainian book as a present. The production of the book was sponsored by our **Federal Foreign Office**.
